Often when we talk about the collected teachings of the Sermon on the Mount, from the beatitudes onwards, there is a tendency to describe how Jesus turned the world upside down, how everything was turned on its head by Jesus' teaching. It is perhaps not the best analogy to use. What Jesus really did was to turn our perspective right way up. He shifts our understanding of reality so that we can grasp that what had been thought to be the final word on what is objective reality was in turn an incomplete view. Jesus does not come to change everything completely, he rather comes to bring better clarity to what already is: "I have not come to abolish [the laws] but to fulfill them." ~ Spill the Beans Resource Team


